Based on Births in One Year The method of procedure followed by the bureau in infant mortality studies is stated at length in the Appendix, pp. 63 to 69. Briefly, the study of infant mortality was based upon the births which occurred in Saginaw during the year ended November 30, 1913, and the deaths under 1 year of age occurring in this group. The plan was to visit the homes and by means of personal interviews with mothers, to collect data about the babies lives to the end of their first year, or until death if death occurred under 1 year of age. Birth records were examined and in each case the facts necessary to identify the baby were transcribed to the schedule 1 later used for the collection of information from the mother. Death certificates were copied for infants whose age showed their births to have occurred in the selected year. At this stage of the work, even when both records existed, it was not always possible...
