The 2nd part contains short outlines to the lectures; key terms and their definitions; a list of abbreviations that are recommended for cursive writing; reading matters and questions to revise knowledge of Stylistics. The 3rd part contains the authors article on convergency as a stylistic device, which may be interesting for further reading in General and Comparative Stylistics; illustrative tables and schemes; some extra examples to several lectures; illustration of linguistic play; a list of basis stylistic terms illustrated by examples; interpretation of some complicated language phenomena; reading matters and a short list of dissertations on Stylistics. This publication is recommended for teachers and students of Linguistic departments and faculties and for those who may be interested in the authors views on categories and types of stylistic phenomena.
