Uilliam English (also known as Liam Inglis) was born somewhere on the borderland of Limerick and Tipperary towards the latter half of the 17th century. There is a tradition that he was at some stage tutor to the young Edmund Burke in East Cork. When he was about fifty years of age he became an Augustinian friar. From then on, until his death in 1778, he was based in the Cork priory of the order, venturing forth at intervals to seek for alms in the surrounding area. This is the first extended translation into English of his poems. He wrote a great many lovesongs and has no inhibitions about describing the more alluring parts of the female anatomy or the energetic activities of lovers. Only one of his poems, not included here, is explicitly religious. But English is religious enough in his joyful affirmation of life and of all that is life-enhancing.
