A graduate of Loyola Law School, Foss also holds a graduate degree in Theology from Sophia Divinity School. He is an initiated Day-keeper (ajq'ij) in the Maya-K'iche lineage, as well as an ordained bishop in an independent Catholic church. His interests include anthropology, spirituality, ritual, cooking, and organic gardening. Foss speaks English, Spanish, and rudimentary K'iche, and works academically with several...
