Pursuant to a congressional request, GAO reviewed ways in which acute nursing care quality could be improved in the Department of Veteran Affairs (VA) facilities, focusing on: (1) organizational changes to enhance the delivery of nursing services; (2) use of information technology to increase bedside nursing time; and (3) allowing the chief of nursing services to report directly to the medical center director. GAO found that: (1) the chief of nursing service in most nonfederal hospitals reports directly to the chief executive; (2) VA tested this reporting structure in one medical center, resulting in improvements in quality of nursing care and in communications between top management and the nursing department; (3) the centers staff, a consultant, and the VA Office of Inspector General recommended that the concept be extended to other medical centers; and (4) VA has not extended the organizational change to other medical centers. In addition, GAO found that: (1) the nursing community holds a generally accepted assumption that the amount of time nurses spend with patients correlates directly with good quality nursing care; (2) nurses could potentially increase...
